

# BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS ENTRY PROTOCOL



When coming to the British Virgin Islands to sail all guests must comply with the following travel protocols:

## BEFORE LEAVING TO TRAVEL TO BVI

- A PCR test should be taken no more than 5 days before arrival (children under 5 do not require testing) with a Negative result test certificate
- Contract COVID-19 medical travel insurance
- Register online, submit your travel details for approval on the BVI Gateway: <http://bvigateway.bviaa.com>

There is a payment of \$175 per person which covers two PCR tests + tracing app, bracelet, and Government certified transport to and from the second test area.

The following documents need to be uploaded onto the gateway :

- Travel insurance,
- Copy of your booked reservation
- Negative PCR tests results certificate

**you must submit them BEFORE you travel.** One submission per traveller including children. Travellers must begin their application no later than 48 hours before travel. Applications on the BVI Gateway portal must be completed at least 24 hours before travel dates and time. All applicants in pending status who have not completed the necessary requirements 24 hours prior to traveling will be denied.

## UPON ARRIVAL IN BVI, YOU MUST:

- Take your first BVI PCR test either at the airport, ferry dock (seaports are expected to reopen to private and public ferry service on January 21, 2021) or medical facility (Day-0 PCR).
- Be fitted with a waterproof tracking bracelet and companion app on your smartphone.
- Be transported by a pre-assigned "Gold Seal" Government certified taxi service arranged by our base staff

## AFTER ARRIVAL AT THE BASE:

- Wait for the negative results on the Day-0 PCR for all guests (24-36 hours) before completing the technical handover and leaving the base on your charter vessel we require a copy of the test certificate per email per person
- Remain on a 4-day quarantine on your charter vessel at the designated mooring points.
- All guests must always stay within 30 ft of the vessel, until quarantine clearance.
- You will be contacted with an appointed time and place to take the second PCR test on Day 4, and clear the quarantine once the negative results are received for all guests (24-36 hours)
- Fly the quarantine flag and keep it up until you clear the quarantine.
- Moor only in approved mooring sites.

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Guests must stay on their vessel until all Day-0 PCR results come back negative. Expect 24-36 hours, though you may need to spend your first 2 nights at our dock.
- Provisions will only be delivered to your vessel (you cannot go to a store!). Orders must be placed 7 days before arrival. For assistance, please contact our base.
